- VI. Elaborating Hamlet's views on the morality of revenge and justice, explain the following soliloquy in Act IV:

  Conscience does make cowards of us all

  And thus the native hue of resolution

  Is sicklied o'er with the pale cast of thought.

- VII. Discuss *Volpone* as a satire on immoral greed, corruption and self-centeredness of the central figure in search of sub-human desires.
- VIII. Explaining the title: *Volpone*, *or the Fox*, discuss its overall significance in the successive developments in the plot of the play.
